

# Why complete the FAFSA?

- Completion or Opt Out is a graduation requirement
- Families assume they won't qualify. In reality...
  many more qualify than you think!
- Families may experience a change in financial circumstances, such as a job loss after the filing deadline
- Some colleges require a FAFSA in order to be considered for certain non-need-based scholarships.
- It only takes about 30 minutes to complete, if you have all necessary info handy

## What to bring:

- Social Security Numbers/ Alien Registration Number
- 2021 Federal Tax Return
- Records of Untaxed Income
- Cash, checking, savings account balances and other investments (other than primary residence)

"IMPORTANT NOTE: FHS does not see, collect or otherwise track this financial data. This data is solely entered by parents into the FAFSA federal government portal.\*\*

## Also Bring:

- Personal laptop or school issued chromebook (Note: if using school chromebook, must log in with student username and password.)
- Student FSA ID (created at school)
- Parent FSA ID (if previously created)
