#### **MAP English I:**

- The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde --Robert Louis Stevenson (Buying an anthology is fine, but students need only read the ONE story.)
- Mythology: Timeless Tales of Gods and Heroes --Edith Hamilton (Part One)

#### **MAP English II:**

- Anthem --Ayn Rand
- A <u>novel</u> of your choice (No *Harry Potter, Twilight, Hunger Games,* or *Divergent* series)
  - --Novel must be high school reading level and a minimum of 150 pages. --Be prepared to "sell" your book during the first weeks of school.
  - --You may NOT choose *Fahrenheit 451* or any other required summer reading titles listed in this letter.
- Mythology: Timeless Tales of Gods and Heroes (Studied during the school year.)

#### **AP English III:**

- Fiction: *The Great Gatsby* --F. Scott Fitzgerald
- Rhetoric and the American Dream:

  Voices of Radical Change: Greatest Speeches of Political and Social Transformation

  --Anne Brown
- Mythology: Timeless Tales of Gods and Heroes --Edith Hamilton ("Adonis"; "The Golden Fleece"; "Hercules"; "Midas")

#### **AP English IV:**

Wuthering Heights --Emily Bronte
 Mythology: Timeless Tales of Gods and Heroes
 ("The Earliest Heroes"; "Perseus"; Chapter 18)
